

Mock Press Event Rulebook

Event Overview:

Mock Press is an individual competition where participants embody randomly assigned personalities and face a simulated press interaction. The goal is to navigate through questions from media representatives (judges) with cleverness, humor, and quick thinking, showcasing their ability to think on their feet.

1. Participants:

The event is limited to a maximum of 8 entries, with participation granted on a first-come, first-served basis.

Participants will receive the assigned personality 24 hours before the event.

2. Presentation:

Each participant will have one minute to impersonate the assigned personality.

This will be followed by a cross-examination lasting five to eight minutes, during which judges will pose leading and non-leading questions.

3. Judging Criteria:

Judging score will be based on the quality of responses during cross-examination.

Criteria includes communication skills (30%), spontaneity (30%), humor (30%), and realistic portrayal (10%).

4. Conduct:

Obscene language and offensive comments are strictly prohibited.

Participants are expected to respect the judges, and the decision of the judges is final.
